**Buildings and Grounds Task Force Update**

The Buildings and Grounds Task Force met on March 27<sup>th</sup>. We are pleased to report that St. Mary's bell is now fully functional and is programmed to ring automatically before all Masses and ring the Angelus sequence at noon every day. We have a remote that we can use to ring the bell during the consecrations at Mass and for funerals and weddings. This is a major event in the liturgical life of St. Mary's! Thanks so much to all who contributed so generously to make this happen for our parish.

We continue to plan and work toward getting the wall behind the tabernacle painted. We are in the process of identifying companies to properly prepare the outside walls of the church, so that we can safely paint the inside wall. The first step will be to "point" the bricks. This process involves grouting the minor cracks within the mortar that have developed over the years. Then the outside of the church will be cleaned with a chemical cleaner to remove all mold and residue. After that is completed we will apply a breathable sealer to all of the exterior walls and the bell tower. After all of that is completed, we can begin the process of painting the interior wall. We have several companies identified for these tasks and hope to be able to begin work soon. Thank you for your patience.
