Buildings and Grounds Update

Tearing Down the Old Rectory. We are in the process of requesting permission from the Architectural Review Board to tear down the old rectory. As soon as we get that permission we will proceed toward that end. We will offer parishioners the opportunity to take items that they might want from the building. After that, we will allow Habitat for Humanity to take what they can use and proceed to have an approved contractor tear down the building.

Removal of sycamore and pecan trees behind the parish hall. The huge sycamore tree, three large pecan trees and two smaller trees behind the parish hall are scheduled to be taken down on December 2nd. The property owner has given us permission to take them down and the city has given approval for their removal.

Hiring an Architect-Engineering Firm

The Buildings and Grounds Task Force has been working to identify the critical areas of focus for an architect-engineering firm. They have identified at least three firms for interview. Once the firm is selected, they will begin to develop a long-range plan to address the critical foundational and structural needs of our campus and parish.

Capital Reserve Study

We have contracted with Giles Flythe Engineering, Inc. to conduct a capital reserve study for our parish. This study looks at all of our physical assets and buildings and projects what the future maintenance costs and replacement costs will be. This will greatly assist our Finance Council in developing long-term budgets for our parish.
