Adult Faith Formation

This Sunday our class will feature "Blessed John Henry Newman: The Convert." This video is part of Bishop Robert Barron's series entitled *Catholicism: The Pivotal Players*. Is there any truth in matters of religion? Should the Church simply retreat in the face of the challenges of culture? John Henry Newman came into the Church as a convert and used his prodigious intellectual gifts to help the Church better understand its identity and mission, and engage the assaults of a secular age. This will be the last session of our Adult Faith Formation until the fall. Come and join us! Coffee and snacks will be served.

Our Pick of the Week is Session 9 from the *Symbolon* Series entitled "Mary and the Saints." What do we think of Mary, the Mother of Jesus, and how does our relationship with her impact our relationship with her Son? What is the connection between our understanding of Mary and the rest of the saints? Why do we ask Mary and other "dead people" to pray for us? The answers to these questions serve to give us a framework for the Catholic Church's teachings on life after death and what we call "The Communion of the Saints." Session 9 is in two parts, Part 1 is 9 minutes and Part 2 is 28 minutes. Film is by the Augustine Institute.
