### Did You Know?

*The Catholic Miscellany* from May 10<sup>th</sup>, had an excellent article on pages 8-9 on "Rules of the Road for Communion Etiquette." Quoting from that article concerning preparing to receive communion: Preparing to receive the Eucharist should begin long before it is time to get in line to approach the altar, according to Father Gregory Wilson, pastor of St. Mary Help of Christians Church in Aiken. "We should think about what we are doing to prepare ourselves to receive in the right frame of mind," he said. "We need to take time for prayers before the Mass, and make sure we pray and pay attention during Mass before we receive. We need to prepare by remembering who, not what, we are receiving. We are receiving Christ." The faithful must be in a state of grace and not under a state of grave sin when receiving the Eucharist. Those in a state of sin should go to the sacrament of reconciliation before receiving.
