New Bilingual Missals and Hymnals Coming Soon

Every four months, we replace about 250 bilingual throwaway missals within the pews of our church. The old missals (about 200 lbs. of paper) have to be taken out to the recycling center and disposed of. Additionally, our hymnbooks are on a three-year cycle and have to be replaced as well. All of this requires a lot of expense, personal labor and impact on our environment.

Pope Francis has urged us to be mindful and respectful of our environment. Accordingly, to save money, minimize the work involved in changing out the missals and protect our environment, we will be getting a new hardcover Sunday Missal (bilingual), which will be called *Word & Eucharist* or *Palabra & Eucharistia*. International Liturgy Publications developed this missal at the specific request of Bishop Guglielmone. It will feature a much larger print, with English on one side and Spanish on the other, with a satin ribbon bookmark.

We will also be getting a new hardcover hymnal, which is entitled *Credo*. This hymnal was selected after close consultation with Edwin Hopkins and Wayne Johnson, our organists, and with liturgical consultants. The *Credo* hymnal is very similar to our current hymnal and is the most complete traditional hymnal in the Catholic Church today. It includes the most beloved and recognized titles from every age, as well as new titles from Catholic composers that specialize in the traditional style.

If you would like to purchase a set of these new books (Sunday Missal and hymnal) in memory or in honor of someone, a donation of \$40 will purchase one set. We will place an engraved plate in the inside cover of the hymnal or missal in memory of your loved one.
