Old Rectory to be Torn Down

We are requesting permission from the Architectural Review Board to tear down the old rectory. Over the past three years, we have made extensive efforts to sell it, give it away or even auction it off. None of these efforts have been successful. Given the rectory's location, it is difficult if not impossible move it with severely damaging it. Moving the rectory (if it could be done) would cost approximately \$30,000. Additionally, it would require about \$150,000 in repairs to make the dwelling livable. Most importantly, the old rectory must be torn down so we can begin to address the serious drainage issues on our campus.

If you are interested in any item (blinds, doors, flooring and etc.) from the rectory, please contact Maria at the church office so that you can review the inside of the rectory. After parishioners have had a chance to salvage what they want, we will allow Habitat for Humanity to take what they want and then we will proceed to demolition.
