Columbus Hope Drive #4, October 11th - 12th, was again a success as 24 Knights and family members were able to step-up and raise \$2,667.03 to wrap-up our drive for the mentally challenged citizens of Georgetown County. Overall 35 Knights and family members raised \$11,372.88 in 2019, against a State goal for our small size council of \$4,400 (258%). Thanks for Walmart for providing us a site to raise this money and to those who were able to donate their time and talent to this worthy and special project. The funds will be given to the following agencies at our January 16, 2020 banquet at St. Mary's Parish Hall: Special Olympics of Georgetown and Williamsburg Counties, The J.O.Y.
